

## **MAC LESSON #4**

### **EASILY RESIZE YOUR DOCK**

The current Mac Operating System uses a Dock to store icons that represent application programs and folders. Your Dock may not appear to be the ideal size for your particular setup. There is an easy way for you to make the Dock larger or smaller. Here's how it works.

Place your cursor right over the divider line on the right side of the Dock that separates your apps from your folders and Trash. At this point your cursor will change from an arrow to a horizontal bar with two arrows, one facing up and one facing down.

Now you can just click-and-drag your cursor upward to make the Dock bigger, or downward to make it smaller.
