

## MAC LESSON 10

### STOP AUTO SOFTWARE UPDATE

Mac OS version 10, like Windows XP, has a system that allows you to download updates to your software. And like Windows, OS 10 offers to download any new updates to the software for you. My problem is that the computer usually wants to do the updates at a time when I'm right in the middle of doing several things. I want to turn off this "feature" so that I can decide when to look for software updates. Here's how it's done.

Click on the Apple menu and then open System Preferences. Click on Software Update. Click in the circle next to Check for updates to disable the feature. Notice that you can control how often the auto update feature bothers you when it's enabled.
