GET NEWS ON YOUR SCREEN SAVER

For one reason or another, most of us don't pay much attention to the screensavers that pop up on our computer screens after a pre-determined period of inactivity.

What if you could get current news on your screensaver? Would you pay more attention to it then? It's not that hard to do if you have Tiger on your Mac. Here's how.

Open the Apple menu and then open System Properties. Click on the Desktop & Screen Saver icon. When those preferences come up, click on RSS Visualizer. Now click on the Options button and pick the feed you want to appear onscreen from the list of approved feeds. Close System Preferences.

The next time your screensaver kicks in, you'll get a live RSS news feed. What a great trick!
