KEEP YOUR STICKIES NOTE UP FRONT

In Mac Lesson 15, you learned how to open, use and then check your spelling in notes you created with the Stickies Widget. What if you have a Stickies note open and want to copy text from a Web site into the note. Do you have to toggle between the note and the Web page? The good news is, no, there's a better way.

While Stickies is your open application, just press Command, Option and F (the command for Floating Window) and this will make your current Sticky note float above your foreground application. Now you can clearly see your note while you are working with another application (like Safari, the Mac Web browser program) because your note will be floating above it.
