When you're connected to the Internet and start browsing through Web pages, some of those Web pages collect information about you and your browsing habits. When you buy products online, these sites keep even more information about you. This is something that really bothers me, so I always want to remain anonymous on the Net. Here's how it's done.

Mac OS X Tiger's Safari updates include a private browsing mode, which lets you surf the web without saving the sites you visit in history, cache, or personal information you enter on the pages.

Just open the Safari browser, click on Safari menu and choose Private Browsing from the drop-down menu. It's that simple.
