### USE ITUNES ALBUM ART FOR YOUR TIGER SCREENSAVER

If you're into iTunes at all, you probably have tons of music album artwork hanging out somewhere on your hard drive. With Tiger, why not use that album art as your screen saver? Here's how.

Click on System Preferences in the Dock. Now click on Desktop & Screen Saver. Click on the Screen Saver tab.

Now you have a list of all of the available Screen Saver options. Click on the one that says iTunes Artwork. Now your Mac will find all of the iTunes album artwork images you have and create a montage of tiles, each representing an individual album. The tiles flip over to a new album. How cool is that?
