SWIRLING WIDGETS

Tired of looking at that widget? Not to worry. You can make that widget go into a swirl and then come back again. The look is really cool, and it serves a purpose. Here's how it's done.

Just click on an open widget in Dashboard, then press Command-R on your keyboard and the widget twirls away and then reappears. It looks great, but beyond that, it does actually reload the widget, as though you just dragged it out from the Widget Bar. That refreshes any data that the widget uses.

A word of caution here. Using this shortcut too much on one widget could cause Dashboard to crash.
