### **CAPTURE THAT WEB PAGE**

The one constant on the Internet is change. Where changes can be troublesome is going back to a Web page that you bookmarked, only to find out that it has changed, and the information you wanted to keep when you bookmarked the site is gone. Bummer.

The good news is that you can save a Web page as a Web archive, which saves the entire page, just as you saw it. That means you'll see the full layout, graphics and all. Every time you open the archive, you'll see the Web page as you originally saw it. Here's how.

With the Web page open in the Safari browser, click on File and then on Save As. Make sure that the Format box is set to Web Archive. Click on Save. That's it - you're done.
