BOOKMARK THAT DVD

If you play DVDs on your Mac, you should know about one of the coolest things Apple added to the DVD player. It's the ability to set up a bookmark while you watch that DVD. Once bookmarked, if you have to stop the DVD or eject it, when you re-insert that DVD you now have the option of starting from the beginning or starting at the place you inserted your bookmark.

To create a bookmark for a particular spot while a DVD disk is playing, press and hold the Command and the Equal Sign key on your keyboard's numeric keypad and that spot will be bookmarked.

A dialog box will appear asking you to type in a name for that particular bookmark. Just enter a name and click OK. It's that easy. The next time you insert that DVD, you'll have the option to start at the beginning or at your bookmarked spot.
