FULL-SCREEN SLIDE SHOW WITHIN MAIL

Sending photographs attached to e-mails is all the rage, and of course you can hardly wait to see the images. But first you'll have to download the attachment and store those images on your Mac's hard drive. Right? Wrong!

The correct answer is that you can instantly see a full-screen slide show of those e-mailed images right from within Mail. Here's how.

When you click on a message to read it, to the immediate right of the word "Attachments" in your e-mail message you'll see two buttons. The first button saves the attached photos to your hard drive. The Slideshow button will open the full-screen slide show of all the photos attached to that e-mail.

To stop the slide show, press the Escape key. To display a list of controls for the slide show, just move your mouse. To make the photos appear larger on your screen, press the F key. Press the letter A to return the photos to their regular size.
