SAFARI KEYBOARD SHORTCUTS

As much as Mac users depend on a mouse to operate their computers, the keyboard is faster and easier and you don't have to move your hands off to the side to grab your mouse. Here are some keyboard shortcuts you can use in Safari, the Mac Internet browser.

Command + N	Open a new window
Command + T	Open a new tab
Command + Click	Open new link in new window or tab
Command + W	Close current tab
Command + Shift + D	Add current page to bookmark menu
Command + Option + B	Open Bookmarks Library
Command + K	Block pop-up windows
Command + Option + E	Empty the cache
Command + Shift + A	Apply AutoFill to an open Web form
Command + Option + F	Jump to the Google search box
Command + Plus (+)	Make text bigger
Command + Minus (-)	Make text smaller
Command + Option + K	Mark page to return to later
Command + Option + P	Return to marked page
Command + Option + V	View page source
