### USE A HOT CORNER

A relatively quick method of locking your Mac-while still leaving your programs running-is to activate the screen saver using a hot corner.

To do this, open the Desktop & Screen Saver System Preferences panel, activate the Screen Saver tab, and click the Hot Corners button. Decide which corner of your screen you'd like to use, then click the corresponding pop-up menu and select Start Screen Saver. Now when it's time to walk away, just fling your mouse into that corner of the screen, and you'll trigger the screen saver.
