PARENTAL CONTROLS IN OS 10 TIGER

Safari 2.0 allows you to use Parental Controls to restrict users to accessing only those web sites that are in the Bookmarks Bar. You can also prevent users from entering web addresses in the address field, using the Google search field, or modifying bookmarks. Here's how it's done.

Use the administrative account to log in as the user and open Safari. Click on Safari in the Menu bar at the top of the window and then open Preferences. Open Security and click to deselect Enable parental controls

Enter the administrator name and password when prompted. Add bookmarks in the Bookmarks Bar for the web sites you want the user to access remove all other bookmarks from the Bookmarks Bar.

When you have finished, click on Safari, on Preferences, then on Security, and click to select Enable parental controls

When you add a Web site to the Bookmarks Bar, the user will be able to visit any page on that site.
