KEEP INSTALLED PROGRAMS FROM AUTOSTART

Occasionally you'll install a program on your Mac that will automatically set itself to run every time you start up that computer. To me, that's a real annoyance. I don't want that to happen. So here's what I do.

Open System Preferences, which you can find on your DOC or by opening the Apple icon at the top left of your screen.

Now open Accounts, located in the System section and then click on the Login Items tab. To hide any item on the list, just click in the checkbox to the left of that item. At the bottom, under the sentence that starts with the word Hide, you'll see a plus sign and a minus sign which you can use to add or remove items from the Login Items list.
