GET RID OF THE SOUND OF SILENCE BETWEEN YOUR MUSIC TRACKS

Some of your music CD's contain tracks that will transition seamlessly from one song to the next. Importing these songs into iTunes can sometimes create gaps between these same tracks, and these gaps are carried over when you copy songs to your iPod. This can be really annoying; the good news is that there is a fix. It's called the iTunes Join CD Track feature. Here's how to use it to create gap-free tracks.

Insert the audio CD in your Mac. The songs on the CD will be listed in the iTunes window. To remove the gap of silence that normally occurs between songs, select two or more songs, click on Advanced, and then click on Join CD Tracks to combine them into a single track.

Now Click the Import button to add the songs to your library. When you store and play these tracks on your iPod, presto - no gaps.
