

## **MAC LESSON #101**

### **FIX A FORGOTTEN PASSWORD**

If you have an administrator account and forget your password, there is a way out. Here's what to do.

Insert your OS X installation CD in the appropriate drive; restart your computer by clicking on the Apple Logo in the upper left corner of your screen and then selecting Restart.

Hold down the C key until the Installer screen appears, and then choose Installer. Now choose Reset Password. Select the drive on which OS X is installed and choose your account from the 1st pop-up menu. Create your new password, and be sure to write it down somewhere. Now, click Save, close the window, and restart your Mac. Bingo, your new password lets you in.
