ENLARGE PDF TEXT

Some times reading the text in a PDF (Portable Document Format) can be difficult, especially if the original document was faxed or scanned and then turned into a PDF file. Well with the Mac OS X Operating System software, it's now easier to read any PDF. Here's the trick.

Hold down the Ctrl key and click anywhere on the PDF document you're working on. Now from the contextual menu, select Zoom Tools and then select Zoom Tools.

To increase the size of the text in your PDF, click the Mouse button (the left button on a 2-button mouse) and drag toward the top of your screen to increase magnification. Drag down toward the bottom of your screen to decrease the magnification.
