GET RID OF THAT WINDOWS PASSWORD SCREEN RESTORE WINDOWS PREVIEW MODE TO EXPLORER

Once you enter a password when starting Windows after an install, the Windows password dialog box will always show up. Here's how to rid yourself of this password hell.

Start Windows and log on with your regular user ID and password. Double-click My Computer and then Control Panel. Double-click on Passwords and, on the Change Passwords tab, click the Change Windows Password button.

On the Old Password line type in your password. Press the Tab key to move your cursor down to the New Password line. Now press Enter (to enter no password). You have now changed your password to no password. Click on Close. The next time you start Windows the Welcome To Windows dialog box will not appear. No more password requests.

After installing Windows Internet Explorer 5.0 you may have problems viewing graphic images, such as jpeg files, as thumbnail views in Windows Explorer.

To restore jpeg file views do the following:

For Internet Explorer 4, click on Start and then select run. Type "regsvr32.exe /i shdocvw.dll" (without the quotes) and press Enter.

For Internet Explorer 5, follow the steps above but type in "regsvr32.exe /i shdoc401.dll" (without the quotes) and press Enter.
