

## **LESSON 94**

### **FIXING AN ERRANT ADDRESS TOOLBAR**

In a previous lesson I showed you how to create a special Address toolbar on your Task bar. Right-click on a blank space anywhere on the Task bar and select Toolbars. Click on Address. The Address toolbar is now active on your Task bar. Type a URL in the open Address box. Press the Enter key to go directly to that Web site.

I found a quirk in Internet Explorer 5 that may keep your Address toolbar from working. It seems that you have to have at least one toolbar enabled on the Task bar in order for the Address toolbar to work.

Right-click on the Taskbar and select Toolbars. Select Quick Launch, Links or the Desktop toolbar and from that point on, the Address toolbar will work properly.

The Address toolbar will store a number of URLs as you use it to connect to individual Web sites. If you have a DSL connection the Address toolbar is really helpful.
