SCROLLING MARQUEE SCREEN SAVER

HAVE IT YOUR WAY

Both Windows 98 and Windows ME offer various kinds of screen savers. To enable the Screen Saver feature, or to change the current Screen Saver settings, right-click anywhere on the Windows Desktop, click on Properties and then click on Screen Saver. One of the choices offered is called "Scrolling Marquee".

The default text in the Scrolling Marquee screen saver is "Where do you want to go today?" a blatant commercial for Microsoft. You can change this text by clicking on Settings.

At the bottom of the Options for Scrolling Marquee box, click on the "Where do you want to go today?" text and type in the text you want to use. You can click on the Format Text button and then select Font, Font style and Size. You can enable effects like Strikeout or Underline. You can also change the color of the text in this same box.

Click OK to return to the Options for Scrolling Marquee box where you can change the color of the background that appears behind the text.
