

## VISTA LESSON 1

### CONTROL WINDOWS WELCOME SCREEN

When you start Vista, you'll see what Microsoft calls the Vista Welcome Center Screen. The Welcome Center Screen gives you information about your computer.

When you get tired of seeing this screen, click on the check mark in the box labeled Run at Startup, located in the bottom left hand side of the Welcome Center Screen. Now close the Welcome Center Screen. The next time you start your computer, the Welcome Center Screen will no longer appear.

To manually bring up the Welcome Center Screen, click on Start and then open Control panel. Click on System or the System and Maintenance link, and click to open the Welcome Center screen.

If you then decide to have the Welcome Center Screen come up every time you start your Vista computer, click to create a check mark next to Run at Startup. It's that simple.
