CHANGE DEFAULT INTERNET EXPLORER SEARCH ENGINE

Vista brings us Internet Explorer (I.E.) 7 as the default browser. One of the features of I.E. 7 is a search capability available in the upper-right corner of the browser. By default, I.E. 7 uses Live Search here, but you can easily change the search engine I.E. 7 uses by default. Here's how.

Click on the down arrow located to the right of the magnifying glass icon and select Change Search Defaults. Now open the link to Find More Providers and select the provider you want to use as the default search engine.

Double-click on the search engine of your choice, and click Yes to add it to the list of search engines available for Internet.

Now you can select from Live Search or any other search engine you have added to the list.
