PUT "MY COMPUTER" COMPUTER ON YOUR DESKTOP

In Windows XP I wanted My Computer on My Desktop and it's no different with my Vista-based computers. I still want Desktop access My Computer (Computer in Vista.) Here's how it's done.

First, click on the Start menu. Then right-click on Computer. Now choose Show on Desktop from the menu that pops up.

Remember that you can always right-click on the Computer icon on your Desktop, click on Rename, and type MY COMPUTER, so you can have it both ways.
